

Extract from Resolution No. 503/2011 of the Chief Executive Officer of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd.

The Chief Executive Officer of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd. (hereinafter: Exchange) announces that, as of November 10, 2011, the following bandwidth will be recommended for the Trading Workstation communication lines specified in Article 2.3 of the „Budapest Stock Exchange’s Regulations on the Operation and Use of the Remote Trading System” (hereinafter: Regulations):

For section members, who do not perform automated quoting neither for BSE’s certificates nor on the BETa market (by using K2 application)

Workstation software type	Communication line bandwidth [kbps]
MMTS I Trading Workstation Software	64
MMTS II Trading Workstation Software	64
Exchange Connection Server operated on the MMTS I spot market (K2)	64
Exchange Connection Server operated on the MMTS II derivative market (K2)	64

For section members, who perform automated quoting for BSE’s certificates or on the BETa market (by using K2 application)

Workstation software type	Communication line bandwidth [kbps]
MMTS I Trading Workstation Software <u>without</u> Firm Manager permission	64
MMTS I Trading Workstation Software <u>with</u> Firm Manager permission	256
MMTS II Trading Workstation Software	64
Exchange Connection Server operated on the MMTS I spot market (K2)	128
Exchange Connection Server operated on the MMTS II derivative market (K2)	64

Values in the tables are applicable for each software that is logged in to the central trading system, independent of whether it’s actively used for trading or not.

This resolution shall enter into force on November 10 2011, resolution 54/2006 of the Chief Executive Officer shall be repealed at the same time.
